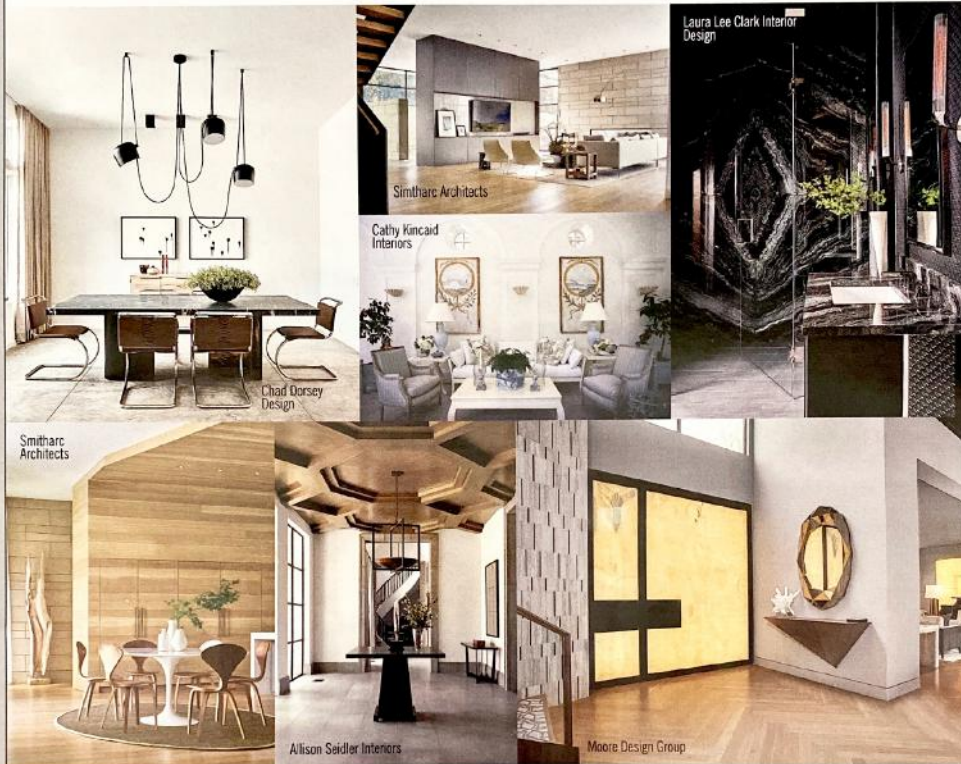


DALLAS *PAPERCITY*
